The Fifth Biennial General Assembly of the Association of Caribbean MediaWorkers (ACM) will take place in Grenada on Saturday December 12, 2009 at 1.00 p.m. at the Blue Horizon Garden Resort.

Member national associations and designated Country Focal Points are invited to attend and to make arrangements for regularising of their memberships for the period 2009-2011. The current subscription for national associations is US\$50 for two years. Focal Points pay the regular membership of US\$30 for two years.
